How can WfBC help me find qualified employees?

One way is through Connecting Colorado. Connecting Colorado is a statewide computerized database where you can enter your own job information and search for qualified workers yourself. You can go to our website [www.wfbc.org](http://www.wfbc.org) and click the brown tab titled "Employers" in the middle of the page, or go directly to [www.connectingcolorado.com](http://www.connectingcolorado.com).

We can also assist you through a Business Service Representative who can list and manage your job openings. Services include screening and referring qualified applicants. Also we coordinate local and regional job fairs. We have two offices, one in Longmont and one in Boulder.

How can WfBC help me train my employees?

### *Customized Training Services*

WfBC works with employers and local training providers to identify the skills needed for a specific job and coordinates an employee training program tailored to employer needs.

WfBC and the employer agree on cost sharing to pay for the cost of the local training providers. Employer costs can be anywhere from zero to 50% based on funds available and type of training.

### *O-J-T (On-the-Job Training)*

WfBC and the employer each pay half of the trainee's salary up to six months. WfBC and the employer together develop a training plan which identifies the skills the individual will learn on the job. Based on the individual's satisfactory completion of the training program, the employer commits to hire the individual.
